



THE EUROPEAN HEALTH INSURANCE CARD

The **European Health Insurance Card** is a free card that gives you access to state-provided healthcare during a temporary stay in any of the 27 EU countries, Iceland, Lichtenstein, Norway and Switzerland, under the same conditions and at the same cost (free in some countries) as people insured in that country.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Airport: ZURICH AIRPORT

You fly to and from **Zürich-Kloten Airport** (<https://www.flughafen-zuerich.ch/en/passengers>)

You can reach Liechtenstein also with Flixbus. Flixbus has a stop in close-by **Feldkirch in Austria**. From there you can travel to Liechtenstein by public transportation. (<https://www.flixbus.com/bus-schedule-bus-stop/feldkirch>)

A network of international rail connections makes it easy to travel to Liechtenstein by train. Rail passengers should travel to Sargans, Buchs (Switzerland) or Feldkirch (Austria), where they can take one of the regular buses (LIEmobil) to the region of Liechtenstein they want.

Buses: LIEmobil (<https://liemobil.li/de>). Buses are coloured yellow. Info on tickets and timetable are on their website.

Police Number: Call the number 117 or 112 which is the European emergency number. But please be sure you will not call the Police. Liechtenstein is a very safe country. However, protect yourself and do not put yourself into risk.

Medical Emergency Number: 144 or 112 which is the European emergency number. In case of a health emergency call also one of our team members to help you. Keep your European Health Insurance Card always with you, along with your ID/Passport. In case of Poisoning emergencies call 145.

ABOUT LIECHTENSTEIN

Liechtenstein is a small country situated on the banks of the Rhine in Central Europe, between the Swiss canton of St. Gallen and the Austrian province of Vorarlberg. The official language is German, though day-to-day affairs are conducted in two Alemannic dialects. Comprising eleven municipalities, the principality is a constitutional hereditary monarchy on a parliamentary and democratic basis. The head of state is Prince Hans-Adam II von Liechtenstein.

Liechtenstein is the sixth-smallest country in the world. Liechtenstein is a doubly landlocked country between Switzerland and Austria. The official currency is the Swiss franc, though euros are also accepted. Liechtenstein is a microstate, and so small that almost everyone knows each other.

The national dish is 'Ribel', made out of cornmeal or wheat semolina. 'Käsknöpfle', a type of doughy pasta covered in melted cheese, is also popular. Fine-dining enthusiasts will find no fewer than five restaurants highly rated by Gault et Millau. In years gone by, cider and wine were the main drinks, while a brewery also produced beer. Today, Liechtenstein's wine has an excellent reputation thanks to the innovative approach used by the region's vineyards.

Citizens speak an Alemannic dialect. Clubs play a major role in everyday life, with over 600 of them spread across the eleven municipalities.

Liechtenstein is a business centre with proven financial expertise, but there is more to the country than just financial services. Thirty large companies employ around 8000 workers, while a further 30,000 people work in foreign branches of companies based in Liechtenstein.
