## PROFILE INTRO



*SEAL CYPRUS is a non-profit organisation based in Nicosia.*

*SEAL CYPRUS stands for Cyprus Organisation for Sustainable Education & Active Learning.*

### *Training for Competence Development*

With participatory teaching and learning methods, SEAL CYPRUS motivates and empowers youth and adult learners to acquire the knowledge, skills, attitudes and values necessary to shape a sustainable future.

### *Educational curricula & eLearning platforms*

We are developing educational curricula for short training courses for youth workers but also for Cooperation Partnerships (former *Strategic Partnerships*). Some examples from projects we are/ were coordinating are: For [ARTSQUAD](#), we created a Train-the-Trainer Curriculum utilising Digital Media, Storytelling, Drama and Music to support youth professionals working with disadvantaged youth. For [CURSOR](#), we developed an In-service Training Programme Handbook. Youth professionals use the handbook to support young learners' career planning using digital tools. For [TRACES](#), we developed a Handbook for youth workers to support youth in managing their digital and online media presence. We are experienced in creating eLearning platforms like the one we have developed for our project [WeGROW](#).

### *Research & Innovation*

We start with a careful needs analysis in every project to address gaps in knowledge, practices, skills, or tools. Our researchers are working following academic standards to gather and analyse insights on contemporary societal issues.

SEAL CYPRUS practices Online Education, Blended Learning, and Digital Youth Work.

We love undertaking the digital part of the projects.

We also love making videos; we are creating Educational Animation to stimulate learning.

## ***Validation of Learning***

We are validating the learning of the beneficiaries of our project using different skills' frameworks: For our international training courses we follow the Youthpass process, and we have implemented two projects specifically on Youthpass.

With our Erasmus+ Strategic Partnership "CURSOR- Crafting Career Roadmaps" we have created resources for Career Planning based on the Career Management Skills Framework of Skills Development Scotland (SDS). For our project DARE- Day One Alliance for Employment which is funded by the EEA & Norway Fund for Youth Employment, we are using the Open Badges system for the validation of learning.

## ***Stakeholder Dialogue***

We pilot the project results (former *intellectual outputs*) with diverse target groups of young people, youth workers, youth trainers/ facilitators, teachers, and adult educators. We are following a Stakeholder Dialogue Model and we are consulting other organisations on stakeholder relations.

## ***Dissemination and Exploitation of Results (DEOR) and Communication***

SEAL CYPRUS has substantial experience in dissemination and communication strategies. We provide training and consulting to other organisations, and we have run projects dedicated to this aspect of the European funded projects.

## ***Standardised project management & Digital Collaboration***

In SEAL CYPRUS, we value efficiency and collaboration. By following standardised procedures in all the managerial aspects of our projects, we focus on the quality of project results. We work with a variety of digital platforms for collaboration, and we are delivering training to other entities on how to use them.

Our aspiration is to be involved in Erasmus+ and other projects funded by Horizon, Interreg, EEA & Norway Grants etc.

We can create educational material, digital tools such as animated videos (we use Powtoon software), and other intellectual results/ project results.

In addition to project operations and project results, we can lead parts of the project such as the Quality Assurance, the Data Management Plan (DMP) and the Dissemination, Exploitation and Communication.

We are very experienced in writing proposals for funding, and we can undertake the task of writing different parts of a proposal.

### ***Our Contribution to Dissemination, Exploitation of Results and Communication***

The implementation of the projects "Make an Impact" and "Dandelion Effect" focusing on Digital Media for Dissemination and Visibility provided our organisation with substantial experience in dissemination and exploitation of project results (DEOR).

Moreover, we will share our experience with campaigning on social media. Our experience in online campaigning in social media includes three successful campaigns: People4soil Citizens Initiative, Campaign on the impact of the social media on the Youth #RealPeople, Campaign on the promotion of the EU Certificate of non-formal education YOUTHPASS.

For our projects, DARE- Day One Alliance for Employment and DARE CYPRUS, we have created a dedicated Communication Plan based on the standards of the EEA & Norway Grants.

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## BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE

### *Type, scope of work, areas of activity and if applicable, approximate number of paid/unpaid staff, learners*

SEAL CYPRUS is a non-profit organisation based in Nicosia, the ethnically divided capital of Cyprus. With our work, we try to overcome the results of the division, and our members are from both ethnic groups.

#### OBJECTIVES

- (1). To provide continuing education to youth professionals, teachers and adult educators.
- (2). To improve the level of key competences of students, young people, adult and senior learners.
- (3). To advocate the recognition of non-formal education, lifelong learning and youth work.
- (4). To reinforce the link between the youth field, adult education, and the labour market.

SEAL CYPRUS achieves excellence by:

- (1). Developing and delivering state-of-the-art youth work, training and coaching.
- (2). Building strategic partnerships to address the learning needs of individuals and organisations.
- (3). Conducting research studies to identify the needs of beneficiaries and target groups.
- (4). Attracting, developing and retaining dedicated and skilled trainers & adult educators.

Starting from the needs of the learners, we provide blended learning solutions based on accurate scientific ground. We use a wide range of innovative interactive educational methods to provide open and distance learning, non-formal Education, e-learning and on-the-job training. We develop e-learning platforms and animated educational videos.

SEAL CYPRUS supports the professional development of teachers, adult educators, youth workers, trainers, mentors of EVS/ ESC volunteers through the coordination of 14 Erasmus+ mobility projects; international training courses:

- "Biodiversity and Active Learning" (2014) on Environmental Education.
- Two projects on Dissemination & Exploitation of Results "Make an Impact!" (2015) and "Dandelion Effect" (2019). These projects provided our organisation with substantial experience that we are applying to all our projects to create a long-term impact on society with our work.
  - "Know the Way- Go the Way- Show the Way" (2015) on Leadership.
  - "Making Ideas Happen" (2016) & "ARTrepreneurship" (2016) on Entrepreneurship Education.
  - "Youth Minded" (2017) about the mental health of young people in the era of social media.

- "Virtual Youth Work" (2021) and "DOTS- Living and Learning in a Connected World" (2022) on harnessing the opportunities the digital worlds represent for Youth Work.

## *Research*

We conduct research to identify the needs and preferences of the key target groups of our projects. In 2015 we profiled the "Youth Trainers in Cyprus".

In 2017, we led research in Cyprus, Estonia, Ireland, and Romania to get an overview of the structure of youth work, the training provision available for youth trainers and youth workers working with young, disadvantaged people, and to evaluate the quality and availability of resources for youth workers.

In 2018 we researched the "Best practices in the design of blended learning curricula and e-learning environments in career guidance of the young people, with a focus on those with fewer opportunities" in Cyprus, Romania, Ireland, and Poland.

In 2019, we led a needs analysis on Entrepreneurship Education and also conducted research on market needs on job profiles, skills and attitudes in Cyprus, Italy, Greece, and Portugal.

In 2020, we researched the Political Dimension of the work of Adult Educators in Cyprus, Belgium, Hungary, and Italy based on the Trainers' Competences Model of the European Training Strategy (ETS).

In 2021, we ran research among Human Resources (HR) Professionals in Cyprus concerning Talent Management.

In 2022, we completed a comparative report on the guidelines for integrating environmental sustainability in European education.

## *Staff- Target Group- Learners*

Our target group consists of young people and youth professionals, adult and senior learners, adult educators, vocational trainers, social workers, school teachers, careers advisers. Our work targets people with fewer opportunities (i.e., people who face social barriers, financial barriers, disabilities, learning difficulties, cultural differences, health problems or geographical difficulties), immigrants and refugees.

We employ 6 full-time and 2 part-time staff, and we are now hiring project officers. To implement our projects, we hire several professionals, including IT experts, trainers, researchers, and career advisers. We have an extensive network that allows us to activate the necessary number of volunteers to undertake social initiatives, activities and events.

Last year, we provided training courses to more than 300 people. The learners were youth professionals, adult and senior learners, adult educators, vocational trainers, social workers, school teachers, careers advisers, and people with fewer opportunities- mainly young NEET and adults from disadvantaged backgrounds.

In 2019, we provided Joint Staff Training to Adult Educators who work with migrants. The topic was leadership skills to promote migrant integration.

In 2020, we provided a Joint Staff Training to youth professionals on Bushcraft (wilderness survival skills) as a tool for competence development.

In 2021, we implemented online workshops for unemployed youth (NEET) in Entrepreneurship Labs for 50 people and Job Labs for more than 150 people.

In 2022, we hosted Learning, Teaching, Training Activities (LTTA) for several projects such as "ADULATION- Adult Education for Social Change", DIG-CIT Strategic Partnership to develop Open Educational Resources for teaching Digital Citizenship", and "YFEP- Young Female Entrepreneurs Program" and more.

During the last four years, we have prepared approximately 120 youth workers and adult educators from Cyprus to participate in mobility projects coordinated by our partners abroad.

**"TRACES- Supporting youth to manage their digital & social media presence" (Youth, 2019- 2021).** With this project, we are developing Digital and Social Media Literacy Curriculum Resources, In-service Training Handbook, Collaborative online Learning Database, E-learning Portal, Library of Case Studies, Guidelines for Youth Workers working with Digital Media.

**"ADULATION- Adult Education for Social Change" (Adult Education, 2020- 2022).** Preparing Adult Educators to lead social change with innovative tools such as Photovoice, Educational Animation (Video), Storytelling, and Kahoot! Quizzes. Topics: Human Rights and Climate Change, the right of the EU Citizens to Data protection and online privacy, Immigration and tolerance to difference, Euroscepticism.

**"WeGROW- EQ learning for YOUTH (Youth, 2021- 2023).** Addressing the need of youth professionals for continuous professional development. The project develops tools to support the Emotional Intelligence (EQ) and the social skills of young people with low school performance, early school leavers, and/ or NEETs.
