About the project

Objectives:

The overall objective is to improve the European Society by supporting youth CSOs, while the specific one is to offer training aimed at the creation and management of CSOs. To do this, the project will develop a collaborative mentoring platform where to interact, share and consult information related to CSOs.

The target group will be young university students from any degree, but with personal plans to found and/or manage a CSO.

Results:

The main results of the project will be:

- Development of a MOOC on Creation and Management of a CSO.
- Development of a collaborative mentoring platform to promote the creation and management of CSOs.

Activities:

The project will develop the following activities:

- Four transnational meetings attended by a total of 48 people.
- One training course, attended by 30 people.
- Five local workshops, for an audience of 300 people in the five countries of the consortium.
- A MOOC on Creation and Management of a CSO.
- A collaborative mentoring platform to promote the creation and management of CSOs.
