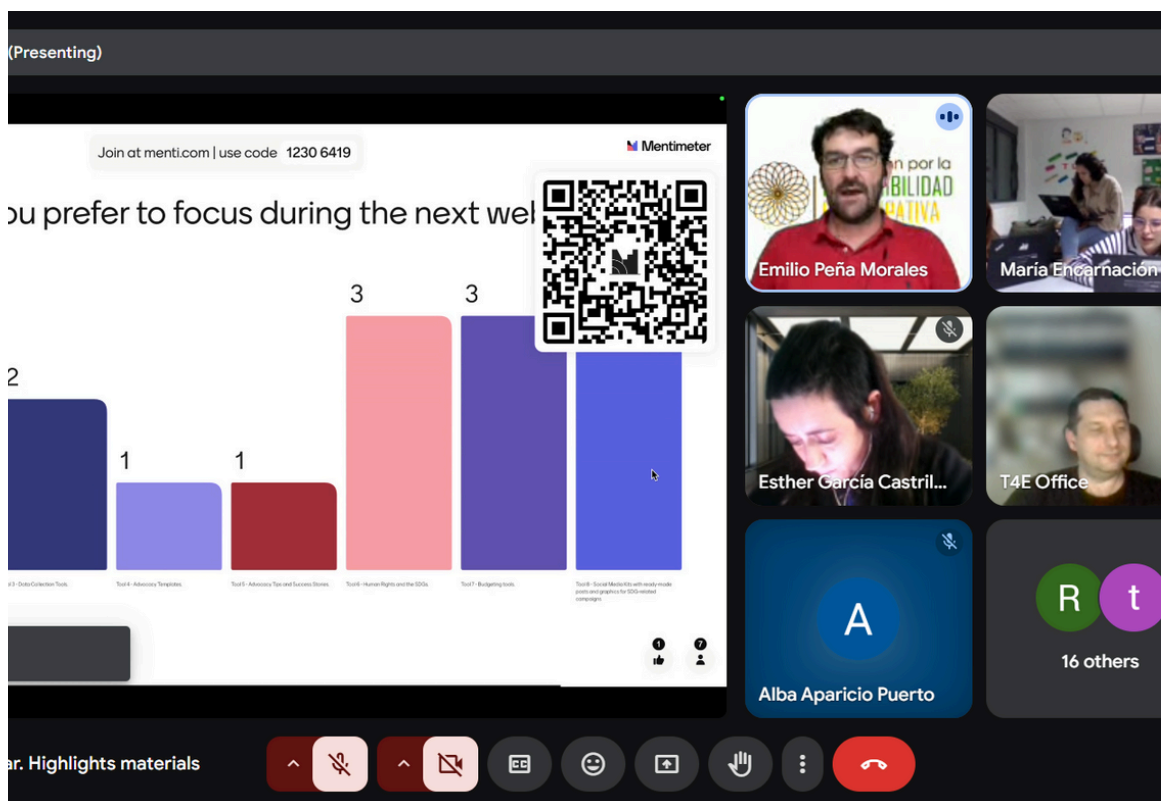

Presentation of the GEN-SDG Project



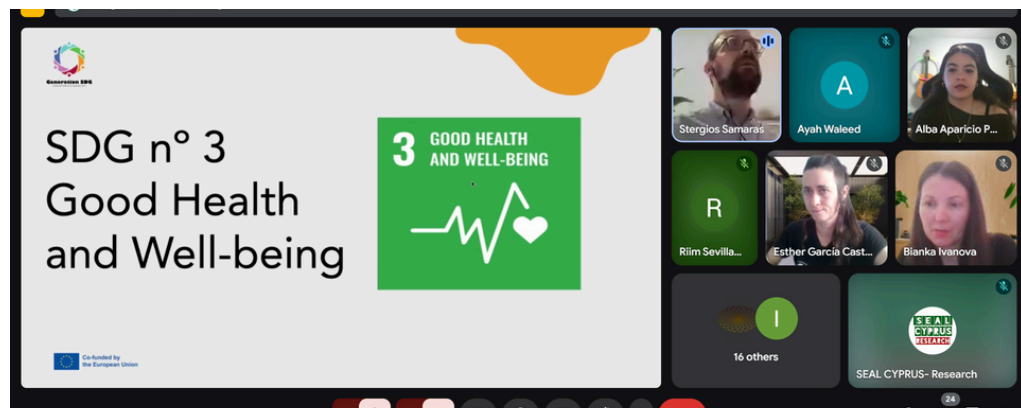

On **May 27th, 2025**, the 2nd Webinar was held, dedicated to presenting the **Toolkit** and delivering a **hands-on training**. The second webinar focused on introducing the educational Toolkit developed within the project. Through interactive demonstrations and practical exercises, participants explored how to use the Toolkit as a tool for learning, awareness-raising, and peer engagement around the SDGs. This hands-on session encouraged youth to take ownership of the material and envision how it could be used in their schools, youth groups, or communities.
